In an effort to improve school climate, positive and negative feedback given to the district will be analyzed and logged throughout the school year. Based on the data, the superintendent will continue or modify programs and policies, keeping the board informed throughout the school year.

In order to improve test scores in math, the superintendent will disaggregate data, work with the principals to establish interventions for students and teachers, and provide training for faculty. Through this work, overall math scores on the PSSA and Keystone tests will show a 20% growth from 22-23 to 23-24 school year.

Through her work with committees, the Superintendent will establish long term plans to ensure growth in all areas of the district. During the 2023-2024 school year, the Superintendent will utilize committees to research and create long term plans in the areas of finance and maintenance.
