

LEA Public Posting regarding the PASA 1.0 Percent Participation Threshold:

The Every Student Succeeds Act (ESSA) requires Pennsylvania to ensure that the total number of students assessed in subjects using the PASA does not exceed one percent of the total number of all students in the state assessed on statewide assessments. Each local educational agency (LEA) must complete and submit the PASA 1.0 Percent Participation Threshold Justification to BSE if it anticipates that more than 1.0% of its students enrolled, the threshold will be made publically available on the PDE website, in accordance with 34 CFR 200.6 (c) (3) regulations. LEAs' must also make the document publically available upon request, removing any personally identifiable information. The Redbank Valley School District anticipates exceeding the 1.0 Percent Threshold for PASA participation during the 2022-2023 testing cycle (1.7%). The necessary justification information has been submitted to the Bureau of Special Education.
